### Kindergarten

- Two Plastic Folders with pockets & fasteners
- Clear window pencil pouch w/zipper & 3 holes for folder
- Kids Scissors
- Two boxes of 24 crayons, (Crayola preferred) basic color
- Last name A-M: black dry erase markers (grade level use)
- Last name N-Z sidewalk chalk (Crayola pref, grade level use)
- 12 glue sticks
- One watercolor paint palette (Crayola preferred)
- Composition Notebook
- Pencil box (to keep supplies in)
- Art shirt (old adult button-down shirt works best)
- Towel for rest time (no large mats, pillows or blankets)
- Spare clothes to keep in the classroom (including undergarments in case of accidents)
- Donations of snack and gallon size baggies are welcome!

### First Grade

- Two boxes of 24 crayons
- Two packages of plain #2 pencils SHARPENED
- One plastic folder with pockets
- Three marble composition notebooks
- Art shirt (old adult button-down shirt works best)
- Six large glue sticks
- Two yellow highlighters
- One small plastic pencil box (to hold all supplies)
- One 1 inch three-ring binder
- Dry erase markers, fine NOT chisel tip (green, red, blue, black)
- One pair school scissors
- Last name A-L: One container of disinfecting wipes and ziploc erasers slider bags (grade level use)
- Last name M-Z: One gallon size zip-loc slider bags and 1 box ziplock quart size slider bags (grade level use)

### Second Grade

- 24 pack of #2 plain wood pencils
- Two spiral one-subject notebooks (2 different colors)
- 24 pack of crayons
- 12 large glue sticks (Crayola/Elmers preferred)
- One pair of scissors
- Plastic pencil box
- Four black thin dry erase markers
- Four marble composition books
- Three plastic folder w/pockets (3 different colors)
- One yellow highlighter
- Last name A-L: zipper sandwich or gallon size baggies (grade level use)
- Last name M-Z: disinfecting wipes (grade level use)

### Third Grade

- One pack of wide ruled notebook paper
- Three packs of #2 pencils (sharpened if possible)
- One pencil pouch (no pencil boxes please)
- One pack of 24 count crayons
- Eight small glue sticks
- Two highlighters, one blue and one yellow
- Five composition notebooks
- One pair of school scissors
- Three black dry erase markers
- Last Name A-G: gallon size baggies (grade level use)
- Last Name H-N: sandwich size baggies (grade level use)
- Last Name O-Z: snack size baggies (grade level use)

### Fourth Grade

- One box of 12 colored pencils
  - Four 12-packs of #2 pencils
  - Six **LARGE** glue sticks
  - One package of loose leaf paper-wide ruled
  - Four yellow highlighters
  - One pencil pouch (no pencil boxes please)
  - Three composition books
  - One (2 pocket) folder, sturdy
  - One 1 subject wide ruled notebook
  - Two 3 subject wide ruled notebooks
  - Two pink block erasers
  - Two black dry eraser markers
  - One pair of school scissors
  - Optional: Snack or Sandwich Baggies (grade level use), your own headphones to use on the computers
- \*\*\*No binders, pens or permanent markers!\*\*\*

### Fifth Grade

- Five dozen #2 pencils
  - One pair of scissors
  - Two large glue sticks
  - Two packs of highlighters
  - One box of colored pencils
  - Zipper pouch to hold all (or most) of the above
  - Two packages of notebook paper (wide rule)
  - One composition notebook
  - Four Expo Markers (1 clean old sock for erasing)
- \*\*\*No pens or permanent markers\*\*\*

**\*\*Note to parents: Plain pencils are preferred; the fancy ones gum-up the pencil sharpeners.**
