2019 SUMMER SCHOOL TUITION RATES

Fees must be paid during registration. Refunds will be issued if the course is cancelled. Refunds will not be issued after the summer session starts. All students must be registered.

Any 4th year students in the Class of 2019 who need <u>one</u> credit (*recovery only*) for graduation may take the applicable course <u>on-line</u> - if available.

Students may take only one class during summer term.

SUMMER SCHOOL RULES & GUIDELINES

ATTENDANCE

- Virginia requires a minimum number of clock hours for credit courses; therefore, attendance is mandatory. Generally, students who miss more than one day will be dropped from summer school. Students must document all absences. Excessive tardies may result in dismissal. Students must attend the last day of the session for all classes.
- Students who arrive after 8:15 a.m. will be charged with a half-day absence.
 Students who have an early dismissal after 11:00 a.m. will be charged with a half-day absence. Chronic tardies or early-dismissals will result in dismissal from summer school.

BEHAVIOR

All FCPS School Board Policies apply and will be enforced during summer school session. Information regarding attendance and behavior will be given to students on the first day of each session by their teachers. Students are expected to follow all rules and regulations during class and break times. Any violations of the Code of Conduct including repeated disruption, defiance, or disrespect will result in dismissal from summer school. Refunds will not be issued to students who have been dismissed. Parents can find the Code of Conduct on the FCPS website under "Parent Link."

GRADES & SOL TESTING

- 1. Final grades will be issued on the last day of summer school. Report Cards will be mailed to parents within 7 business days of the last day of class.
- 2. Seniors who pass a final required course and all graduation requirements will be eligible to receive their diploma at the conclusion of the summer session.
- 3. Students will be given the opportunity to take the corresponding SOL test during regular school hours, if applicable.

MEALS

1. Meals are not provided by the cafeteria during summer school; students must bring their own lunches and snacks. Additionally, Southeastern does not have vending machines, and students are not allowed to go off campus during lunch time to purchase lunch.

TRANSPORTATION

- 1. Parents/students are responsible for their own transportation as FCPS does not provide bus transportation for summer school. Excessive tardies in morning drop-off or afternoon pick-up will result in dismissal from summer school.
- 2. Students who drive to summer school must park in assigned areas. Students will not be allowed to go to their cars or leave school grounds during the school day without administrative permission. Violation of this requirement will result in dismissal.
