Lucy Cantrell, Director of Information and Referral at The Arc of Virginia, will discuss accessing all four of Virginia's waivers (to include CCC+ waiver and the three DD waivers), how they compare, and how to apply/manage service connections.

The Division of Rehabilitative Services (DRS) works together with students, youth, families, schools and community agencies and organizations to provide services that promote successful transitions from school to work and adult life. DRS offers two sets of services to help students with disabilities move from school to post-school life: pre-employment transition services (Pre-ETS) and vocational rehabilitation (VR) transition services. Nikki Mangold, Pre-ETS counselor and Lynn Stephenson, VR counselor will present their services and how to access.
