TEXTBOOK INFORMATION:

Students were issued one or more textbooks for the Fall term utilizing a computerized barcode system. All students were encouraged to write their names in those books. Students on occasion pick up the wrong textbook from a classroom or the cafeteria—not the one issued to them. They use it and turn it in at the end of the term.
